

2012 ELECTION SCHEDULE

January 10, 2012 - Presidential Primary:

- ▶ **January 3 (Tuesday) 7:00 - 7:30 pm** - Supervisor Session at City Hall. Note: Last day to register to vote at City Hall prior to the Presidential Primary.
- ▶ **January 9** - Last day for Absentee Ballots to be returned in person to City Hall.
- ▶ **January 10** - Presidential Primary - polls open from 8:00 am - 7:00 pm.

March 13, 2012 City/School Election:

Registered voters will be electing 5 City Councilors (one from each ward and two at-large) for two-year terms, 2 at large Library Board Trustees for three-year terms, 3 School Board members for three-year terms.

- ▶ **January 28 (Saturday), 11:00 -11:30 am** - Supervisor Session at City Hall. NOTE: Last day to register to be able to vote at the February 4th School District Meeting. (Absentee voting and registering to vote the day of the meeting is not permitted by state law.)
- ▶ **January 30 (Monday), 7-7:30 pm** - Supervisor Session at City Hall.
- ▶ **January 31 9:00 am - February 14, 5:00 pm:** The filing period for City Council, Library Trustees, School Board Members and School District Officials
- ▶ **February 4 (Saturday)** - Lebanon School District Annual Meeting - 9:00 a.m.
- ▶ **February 26** - Expected date for Absentee Ballots to be available.
- ▶ **March 3 (Saturday), 11:00 -11:30 am** - Supervisor Session at City Hall.
- ▶ **March 12** - Last day for Absentee Ballots to be returned in person to City Hall.
- ▶ **March 13** - City/School Election - polls open from 8:00 am - 7:00 pm.

Declarations of Candidacy for City Council and Library Trustees are filed with the Office of the City Clerk in City Hall. Declarations of Candidacy for School Board Members is done through the Superintendent of Schools Office.

September 11, 2012 State Primary:

- ▶ **June 5 (Tuesday) 7:00 - 7:30 pm** - Supervisor Session at City Hall (*Last day to change party affiliation prior to September Primary.*)
- ▶ **June 6 at 9:00 am - June 15 at 5:00 pm.** Filing period for State Representatives and Delegates. Declarations of Candidacy are filed with the Office of the City Clerk.
- ▶ **September 4 (Tuesday) 7:00 - 7:30 pm** - Supervisor Session at City Hall. Note: Last day to register to vote prior to the State Primary Election.
- ▶ **September 10** - Last day to accept Absentee Ballots returned in person
- ▶ **September 11** - State Primary. Polls open 8:00 am - 7:00 pm.

November 6, 2012 General Election:

- ▶ **October 26** - Last day to register to vote at City Hall prior to the General Election.
- ▶ **October 27 (Saturday) 11:00-11:30 am** - Supervisor Session at City Hall (last opportunity to register to vote prior to the General Election).
- ▶ **November 5** - Last day to accept Absentee Ballots returned in person.
- ▶ **November 6** - General Election. Polls open 8:00 am - 7:00 pm.

Residents may register to vote with the Clerk's Office Monday through Friday, 8:00 am until 4:30 pm or at a Supervisor of the Checklist Session (dates noted above). There is a 10 day cut-off for voter registration prior to each election. However, residents may register to vote at the polling place on election day with proper identification.

Polling Locations and Hours:

Polling places for all of the above election dates are as follows:

- Ward 1 - Kilton Library, Main Street, West Lebanon.
- Ward 2 - United Methodist Church, School Street, Lebanon
- Ward 3 - Lebanon College, Hanover Street, Lebanon

Polling hours for all three wards will be 8:00 am until 7:00 pm.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

Registered voters may vote by Absentee Ballot for the following reasons:

- ▶ Physical disability
- ▶ Religious observance
- ▶ Absence from town or city on day of election
- ▶ Employment obligations do not allow voter to get to the polls on day of election
