

## **VOTER REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

### **How do I register to vote?**

- ~ Appear at the City Clerks office or a Checklist Supervisor session prior to election day or at the polling place on election day.\*
- ~ Complete the Voter Registration form.
- ~ Fill out a voter registration card and present proof of identity, citizenship, age and residency in Lebanon, NH. If you do not have proof of citizenship or residency, you will fill out a citizenship and/or domicile affidavit.

\*Note: there is a 10-day cut off period prior to each election for registering to vote.

### **What documentation do I need for Voter registration?**

**To Register to Vote, you must prove your identity, age and residency. The following documents can be used for proof:**

#### **To prove identity:**

- Driver's License
- Birth Certificate
- Passport
- Any photo identification

#### **To prove age:**

- Drivers License
- Birth Certificate
- Passport

#### **\*To prove residency:**

- Drivers License
- Auto Registration
- Dated Rent Receipt, pay stub, utility bill
- Water/Sewer or Property tax bill
- Hunting or Fishing License
- Bank Statement

\*Domicile may be proven by the signing of an affidavit of domicile if the above documents are not available.

## **Where and When do I register to Vote?**

- ~ The City Clerk's Office at 51 North Park St, during normal office hours.
- ~ At a session of the Supervisors of the Checklist. Days, hours and places are posted 7 days prior to the session.
- ~ At the polling place the day of elections.

## **What Ward do I live in?**

City of Lebanon has three separate voting wards. To determine which ward you are in, please refer to the ward map or list of streets/wards on the City's web site or contact the City Clerk's Office.

Polling locations for the wards are as follows:

**Ward 1:** Kilton Public Library  
Main Street, West Lebanon

**Ward 2:** Methodist Church  
School Street, Lebanon

**Ward 3:** Lebanon College (basement level)  
On the Downtown Mall, Lebanon
