














PANTRIES SERVING THE UPPER VALLEY AREA (revised 09/28/2011)

Daily visits are allowed to pick up free produce/fruits and one loaf of bread (if more is available a sign will be posted).	Green Line: Coming from Datamann or Hanover, stop is at the corner of Pierce St. & Hartford Ave., next to the Laundromat. Coming from West Lebanon, stop is between the Upper Valley Haven & the Church.
