

2009-10 LEBANON CITY MANAGER GOALS

1. PRIMARY GOALS

- A. Residents' interests: In all planning efforts, continue to apply the council resolution, adopted 6/18/08: "All actions and policies of the government of the City of Lebanon shall be intended first and foremost to benefit the current residents of Lebanon."
- B. Sustainable Principles Document: Present final version to Council for review and adoption. **(9/30/09)**
- C. Natural Resources Inventory: Present final version to Council for adoption as fundamental planning tool. **(9/30/09)**
- D. Cost of Community Services Study. Present revised version to Council for adoption as fundamental planning tool. **(6/30/10)**

2. SECONDARY GOALS (Informed by 1.A – 1.D)

- A. Master Plan Update. Ensure that citizen willingness to give time and effort is respected. Evaluate committee results. Present interim document to the Planning Board, Council and other appropriate boards and committees. Ensure that final document is consistent and workable. Prepare final version for Planning Board and Council review and adoption. **(PB - Winter 2009, CC – Early 2010)**
- B. Action Plan. Replace present Strategic Plan. Prepare revision (Master Plan Action Plan) for Council review and adoption. **(6/30/10)**
- C. Open Space Plan. Once 1. B-D are accomplished, work to prepare for Council review and adoption. **(4/30/2010)**
- D. Zoning Ordinance Revision. Work to complete for inclusion on March 2011 ballot. **(March 2011)**
- E. Transportation Master Plan: Budget for and commence a transportation action plan based on the updated Lebanon Master Plan. **(11/1/2010)**
- F. Coordinate and work to develop an action plan for revitalization of West Lebanon, including Westboro. **(6/6/2010)**
- G. Conduct a baseline assessment (LEAC) of the City's energy use and create an action plan to implement viable LEAC recommendations and City policies **(9/1/2010)**

All dates referenced in Sections 1 & 2 above are approximate and subject to change.

3. ONGOING GOALS

- A. Community Communication: Continue to utilize current and find new or improved ways to communicate with the public to gather more citizen input and make municipal government more open and accessible. Work to improve communication among all stakeholders. Work to improve public trust and involvement.
- B. Planning Excellence: Work to develop an inventory of planning metrics and associated tools to improve the City's planning efforts. Work to achieve planning excellence and congruence in the City of Lebanon.
